## **Privacy Notice**

FACTS	What Does ChangePath Do with Your Personal Information?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:  • Social Security Number and investment experience  • Income and risk tolerance  • Assets and account transactions  When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons ChangePath chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

WHAT WE DO		
How does ChangePath protect my information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and building.	
How does ChangePath collect my personal information?	<ul> <li>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</li> <li>Open an account or give us your contact information</li> <li>Seek advice about your investments or tell us about your investment or retirement portfolio</li> <li>Enter into an investment advisory contract.</li> <li>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates or other companies.</li> </ul>	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<ul> <li>Federal law gives you the right to limit only:         <ul> <li>Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>Affiliates from using your information to market to you.</li> <li>Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you.</li> </ul> </li> <li>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</li> <li>See the Other Important Information section for your rights under state law.</li> </ul>	

DEFINITIONS	
Affiliates	Companies under common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial.  • Our affiliates include Creative One, LLC and Client One Securities, LLC.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial.  • ChangePath does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  • ChangePath does not jointly market.

## OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION We will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of ChangePath, unless California permitted by law. For example, we may share your information to service your accounts. We will Residents limit sharing among ChangePath and its affiliates to the extent required by California law. Nevada law requires us to disclose that you may request to be placed on our internal "Do Not Call" list at any time by calling (888) 798-2360, and that you may obtain further information by Nevada contacting the Nevada Attorney General, 555 E. As a resident of Vermont, we will automatically limit sharing of your information outside of the Vermont ChangePath corporate family, unless otherwise permitted by law. We may share information with Residents your consent or to service your accounts.
